

In March of 2019 The Lionheart Foundation's program for youth at-risk, **The Power Source Program**, was accepted into [CrimeSolutions.gov](https://www.crimesolutions.gov), an evidence-based repository which serves as a clearinghouse of information about what works and what has been identified as promising in justice programs and practices.

The [CrimeSolutions.gov](https://www.crimesolutions.gov) project, overseen by the U.S. Department of Justice's National Institute of Justice, reviewed the existing research literature to identify "effective, quality programs and practices in the fields of criminal justice, juvenile justice, and crime victimization to serve as evidence-based models for the field."

In addition to being listed in Crime Solutions, The Power Source program will also be included in the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention's (OJJDP's) Model Programs Guide.
